- UCM, UCB, and UCR have one stops.
- UC Merced opened one stop shop simulatively with the opening of the university.

- Quilty Service Standards: Care, Guidance, Access, Efficiency
- 80/20 Model: Answer 80% questions that come in and 20% to send out to home offices.
 - o Tier options: tier one is simple questions that are answered by student employees
 - o Tier two: Professional staff answer questions.
